The Twin Buttes are a natural landmark, with the ducks symbolizing the Bird Refuge near Hamer. The powerful Snake River, winding its way majestically through the valley and between the Buttes, furnishes electric energy and also irrigation water for the valley. Natural species of trees such as cottonwood, poplar and juniper surround the rustic log cabin, typical dwelling of the pioneer settlers. Sagebrush signifies what was expressed by the pioneers as a "sea of sagebrush" and grew shoulder high along the fertile banks of

the river. The Great Feeder headgates and canal system makes the County into the concentrated network of canals and irrigation ditches, which is not equalled any place in the world. The potatoes, book, football and medical emblem signify outstanding performance and accomplishments in various fields, Rigby High School, the birthplace of television, where in the mind of a young high school student the theory of television was conceived and diagrammed on the blackboard.

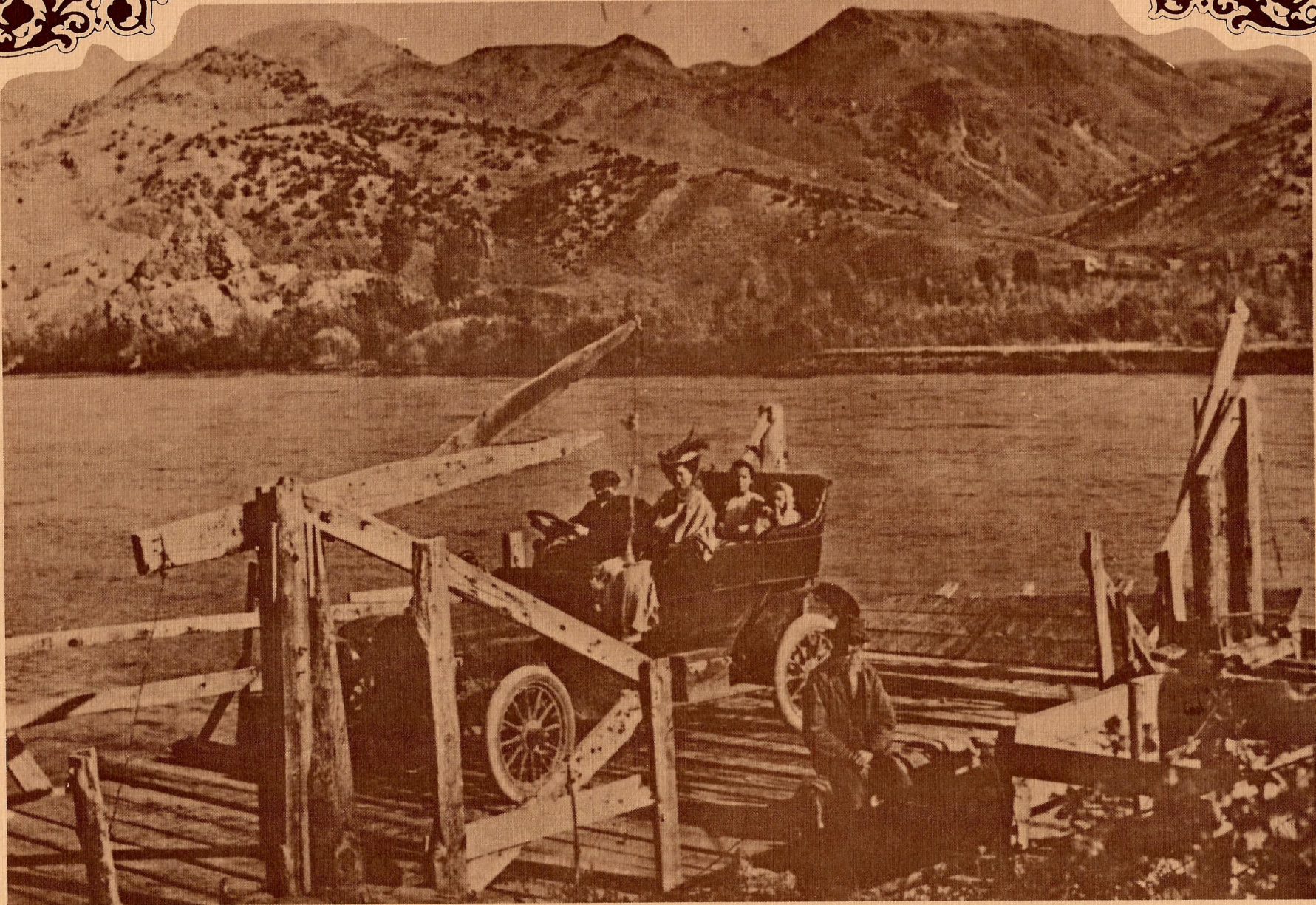

Around 1900, the Upper Ferry was built three miles above Heise Hot Springs. Thomas Morgan (sitting on the side) purchased the ferry in 1906 at the age of 99. He operated this ferry successfully for five years. Ezra Rapp and Sons purchased the ferry from Earl Morgan in 1931 and operated it until the Heise Bridge was completed in 1938.









The Fisher home was built by Oliver C. Fisher prior to the turn of the century. Oliver built the house using black sandstone rock brought from Butte and squared logs. The house was warm in the winter and cool in the summer. It had six large rooms plus a pantry that was used for keeping barrels of flour and sugar . It was here that Alice Fisher made her pies, biscuits and cookies. There was also a handy cellar behind the house for storing fruits and vegetables.

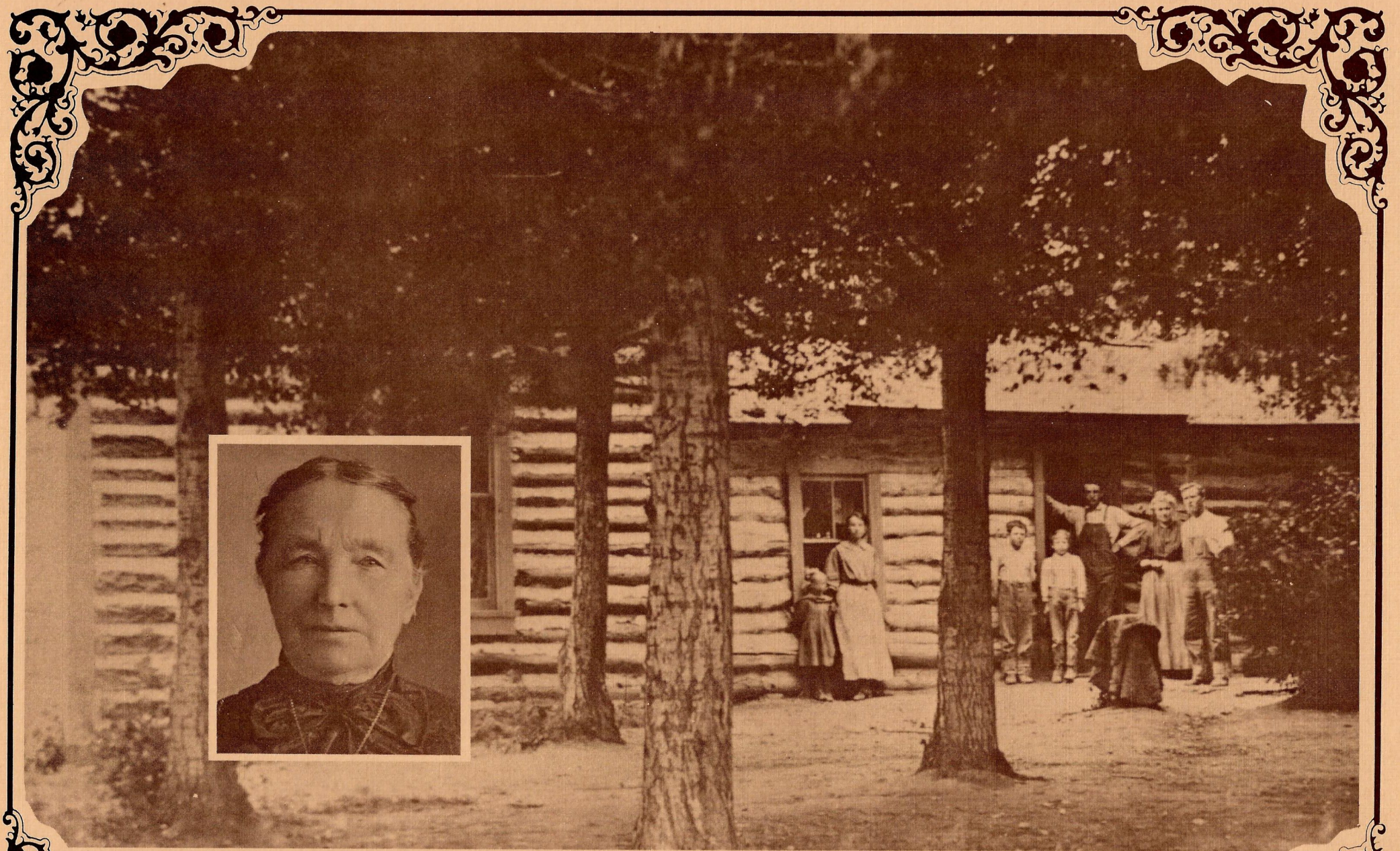

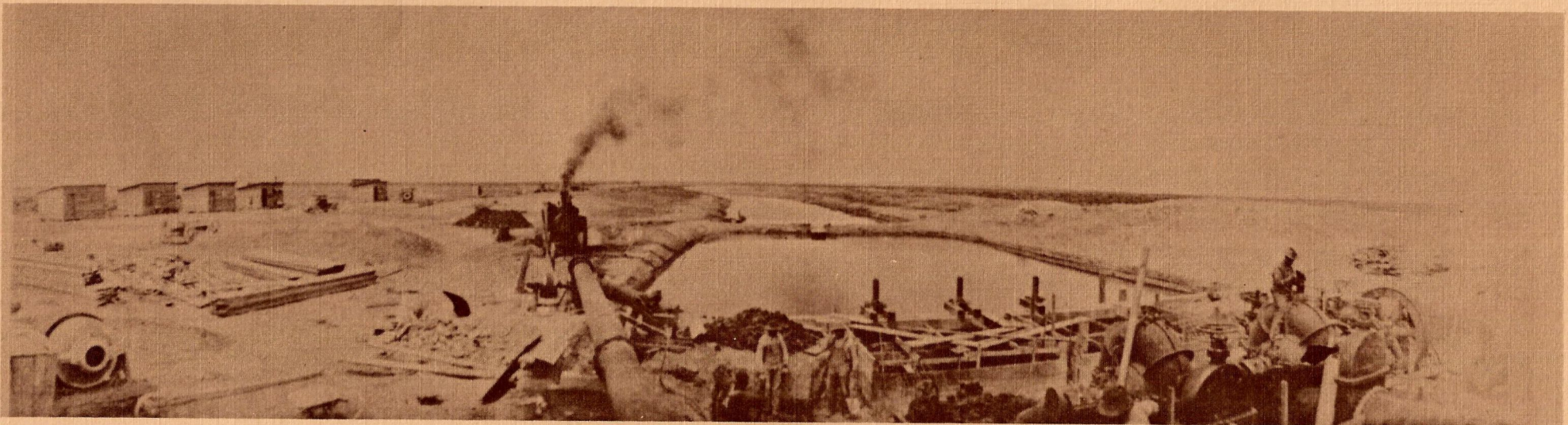
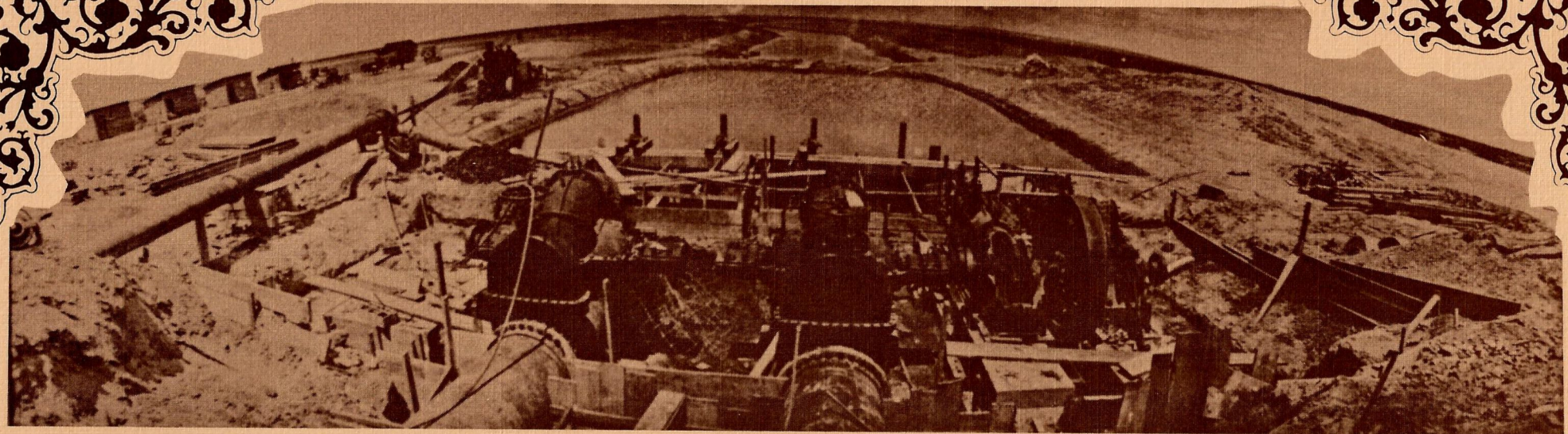
