Minutes of "Special City Council Meeting on Sewer & Water" held August 14, 1970 in Menan LDS Church.

Purpose of the meeting was to discuss Sewer and Water System in the City of Menan.

Meeting came to order 8:15. Mayer Robert Watson was in charge.

Mayor Watson spoke on the approximate cost of the system, \$491,500.00. \$235,600.00 to be in form of a Federal grant, and the balance of \$255,600.00 to be financed in some sort of a loan.

Mayor Watson introduced the following speakers: Wayne Thomas, FHA office in Rigby; Ross Kelley, Board of Health; Clator Forsgren, Engineer; T. Harold Lee and his associate, James Ririe, City of Menan's legal counselors; we claused Thurson.

Ross Kelley spoke on water, Contamination of water, purity of water, public health hazards, the saturation of sewage into the soil forming contamination in the water.

Clator Forsgren spoke on why the need of a new comunity well NOW, Looking ahead, extra protection on a Community Project, and future Community growth.

T. Harold Lee spoke on the different ways to finance the balance of the money needed; General Obligation Bond, Revenue Bond, or an Association. He discussed the legality of a Bond Issues, connections with FHA, and Status of the Law. Recommendations: An Association on a Non Profit basis with a tempory Board of Directors, complete with by laws, with permant arrangements for franchise for guarantee to repay loan. It takes a 2/3 majority to carry on both the grant and the loan.

Wayne Thomas spoke on the cost of maintance and reserve, and how each was to be financed.

Mr. Elwood Theuson spoke on the Basis of water, comparison of costs. the clarification on the availability of the grant, 80% of the residents of Menan would have to join the association for the grant to be available; Reserve fund, purpose and use.

Each speaker held a question and answer period on the advantages and disadvantages of a Community System.

City Board members present were: Mayor Robert Watson, George Davey, Otto Gouer, George Maloney,

Mayor Watson asked for people in favor of an association to sign up and make a deposit of \$10.00 each.
